APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Member Gould moved that **the Board approve the open session minutes of its Regular Meeting of March 27, 2014**. Member Vander Weele seconded the motion. The Board approved the motion unanimously by roll call vote.

Des Plaines Development Limited Partnership d/b/a Harrah's Joliet Casino & Hotel
 Waiver of the Two Meeting Rule Related to Approval of a New Game – High Card Flush

Based on staff's investigation, Member Holewinski moved that the Board waive the Two Meeting Rule related to the request by Harrah's Joliet Casino & Hotel for the approval of a new game of High Card Flush.
