

**Regular Meeting, Open Session Minutes - Riverboat
Illinois Gaming Board

June 28, 2017**

On Wednesday, June 28, 2017, a Regular Meeting - Riverboat of the Illinois Gaming Board (“Board”) was held on the 5th floor at the Michael Bilandic Building in Chicago, Illinois at 9:03 A.M. Present were the following: Chairman Don Tracy, Members Hector Alejandro, Steve Dolins, Thomas Dunn and Member Dee Robinson.

APPROVAL OF OPEN SESSION MINUTES:

Member Dunn moved that the Board approve the open session minutes from its Regular Meeting of May 25, 2017. Member Dolins seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by roll call vote.

OWNER LICENSEE ITEMS

Initial Consideration (No Board Action / No Vote Required)

- Casino Queen, Inc. – License Renewal

Member Dolins moved that the Board table consideration of the Level One Occupational Licensee application of **Chinedum Austin Otigbuo** until its next regular meeting. Member Robinson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by roll call vote.

Member Robinson moved to revoke the occupational licenses of **Tashawn Story** and **Candace J. Rembert** for their conduct of consuming alcohol while on duty at Rivers Casino, said action to take effect 21 days from the date of service of the Complaint, unless an Answer to the Complaint is properly filed within that time frame. Member Dolins seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by roll call vote.

Member Dolins moved to revoke the occupational license of **Obdulia Valdez** for her conduct of theft at Rivers Casino, said action to take effect 21 days from the date of service of the Complaint, unless an Answer to the Complaint is properly filed within that time frame. Member Dunn seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by roll call vote.

Member Dolins moved to revoke the occupational license of **Natalie Marie Patete** due to a retail theft arrest and her non-cooperation with a Board investigation, said action to take effect 21 days from the date of service of the Complaint, unless an Answer to the Complaint is properly filed within that time frame. Member Robinson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by roll call vote.

Member Dolins moved to revoke the occupational license of **Adam Nelson** for his conduct while employed by Hollywood Casino Joliet, said action to take effect 21 days from the date of service of the Complaint, unless an Answer to the Complaint is properly filed within that time frame. Member Robinson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by roll call vote.
