RE: Charitable Donations via Redemption Kiosks in the Casino

Dear Mr. Fruchter:

On behalf of the Illinois Casino Gaming Association (ICGA) and its member casinos, we appreciate the opportunity to submit comments in response to the Board's request for ideas and proposals to facilitate charitable donations of gambling winnings through redemption kiosks at Illinois Casinos.

The technology for this functionality already exists for many of the approved redemption kiosk units currently utilized in casinos. For instance, the NRT brand redemption kiosks have a charity donation module available that has been independently tested and certified by Gaming Laboratories International (GLI). This module provides patrons with the option to donate coin/change and unredeemed balances from TITO tickets inserted into the redemption kiosk through the kiosk screen. Reports can be generated to reflect the amounts donated to each charity for reconciliation and remittance to the respective charitable organizations. If required, detailed procedures can be submitted to the IGB, similar to those as required by the Charity Donation MICS, Section G-14.

The ICGA believes this functionality provides several benefits:

- Convenience for patrons who wish to donate small balances (e.g. coin/change) that are
 often left unredeemed. Many patrons may otherwise throw away these low value TITO
 tickets.
- Enhanced public goodwill by offering patrons a voluntary, convenient way to give back to their community.
- Simplifies the process as it exists today for the donation of TITO tickets.

To help understand how this functionality works, we are including a document titled, "NRT Charities Module Screen Images", which illustrates how the donation feature is presented to patrons during the TITO ticket redemption process. Patrons will always be given the option to proceed with a normal redemption or to make a donation to charity. Additionally, should you want to review it, we are attaching the GLI certification letter and test report for the NRT Charities Module.

We appreciate the Illinois Gaming Boards consideration of this functionality and are encouraged by the opportunity to easily support charitable giving through the use of this type of technology.

Re: Comments Regarding Charitable Donations

Dear Mr. Miller:

The Illinois Gaming Machine Operator Association (the "IGMOA") supports enacting a new Rule, or an amendment to existing Rules, to allow patrons in the Illinois gaming industry to have the option to contribute all or a portion of their winnings to winnings to either a bonafide charitable organization or to the Department of Human Services for administration of programs for the treatment of compulsive gambling or the Illinois Gaming Board for research into issues affecting compulsive gambling, at the point of redemption. The IGMOA believes interested charitable organizations should be required to meet certain minimum standards, such as being registered as a 501(c) and in existence for a minimum of three years in order to be eligible to receive any winnings. The IGMOA recommends that the IGB create and maintain a publicly available list of approved charitable organizations for this purpose. The IGMOA further believes terminal operators should be able to choose, at their discretion, which of the approved charitable organizations to make available for contributions at their respective points of redemption. The IGMOA looks forward to collaborating with IGB staff to implement a Rule that allows for charitable contributions by patrons and that otherwise furthers the goal of the Illinois Video Gaming Act.



The CHS-1.4.0.0-ServicePack-01.exe v5-6-21 is MODIFYING the previously certified notifications.exe v1.4.0.0. The modifications are as follows:

- 1. Fixed crashing on startup with Windows 7 due to XFS SEL (NEO, PC280, PC280n).
- 2. Fixed SOP barcode scanner diagnostic screen, scanned barcode value is overlapped by other text.
- 3. Added support for addon module which lets the patron donate their coin amount to charity.
- 4. Added welcome screen player's club button, used to launch WAT-type interfaces (only Konami currently)
- 5. Added CHSConfig2 option to enable JCM LogicGen as the kiosk's ticket printer.
- 6. Fixed tickets able to be redeemed by barcode scanner while BVs are also enabled.
- 7. Added option to change device reference name for dip card reader (eg. CSCIDU -> CSCIDU#2).
- 8. Added option to ignore dip card reader cancellation errors. rather than try to reset and reinitialize.

Subject: [External] GVC Comments on Implementation of Charitable Donations via Redemption Kiosks

To participate in a Caesars Entertainment enterprise-wide initiative, *Caesars Makes Change*, and raise much-needed funds for eligible non-profit organizations, Grand Victoria Casino submitted and received Illinois Gaming Board (IGB) ICS approval for the NRT Charity Module (JIC23004) in December, 2023. Shortly thereafter, while preparing for the implementation of this project, NRT informed us that they had not yet received approval from the IGB for Charity 1.1.1.0.exe, (the software required to enable the Charity Module functionality) which NRT submitted in February, 2023. In November, 2023, IGB advised NRT that Rules had not yet been developed for this type of procedure (charity).

As of June, 2025, lifetime-to-date donations (since mid-2022) from participating Caesars Entertainment properties utilizing the NRT Charitable Module is an impactful \$5 million, benefiting organizations that include Boys & Girls Club of America and Meals on Wheels. These national organizations provide pass-through funding to many of the local affiliates where we operate. *Caesars Makes Change* also gives participating properties the flexibility to select local organizations which would help address critical needs in our communities — supporting food banks, senior centers, literacy programs and more. This flexibility allows us to tailor our giving to each of our community's unique needs.

It is our understanding that Illinois is the only state that precludes casinos from participating in this type of program. Grand Victoria is committed to helping our neighbors and would greatly appreciate IGB's consideration and approval of our participation in this charitable initiative which would benefit Illinois communities in need.
