Request to Prohibit Wagering on Injuries, Officiating Related, Player Conduct and Pre-Determined Events in any National Football League Game

Rule 1900.1130 Order

## FINAL BOARD ORDER

This matter comes to the Illinois Gaming Board ("Board") for final action pursuant to 11 Ill. Adm. Code 1900.1130. On October 4, 2024, the National Football League submitted its Rule 1900.1130 Request to Prohibit Wagering on Injuries, Officiating Related, Player Conduct and Pre-Determined Events in Any National Football League Game ("Request"). The Board, having reviewed the record, including all comments received, hereby orders that wagers on the following portions of National Football League contests or related activities are **PROHIBITED**:

- 1. Player injuries;
- 2. Fan safety or activities;
- 3. Player misconduct, including but not limited to off-field conduct, suspensions, or fines;
- 4. Penalties;
- 5. Replay results;
- 6. Officiating assignments;
- 7. First play of the game;
- 8. In game or in week roster or personnel decisions, including but not limited to game day actives, practice squad elevations, starting lineups, and total snaps played. This does not prohibit wagers on roster construction decisions, including but not limited to the NFL draft, free agency signings, or trades;

- 9. Player to miss a field goal or extra point; and
- 10. Quarterback's first pass of a game to be incomplete.
